- Jesus has always existed

- Matthew traces through Joseph
- Luke traces through Mary

Lk 1:5-25

Birth of Jesus Foretold

Lk 1:26-38

- Virgin
- Pledged to be married
- Nazareth
- Young – Poor – Illiterate
- “Highly Favored”
- Mary needed a Messiah as much as we do!
- “Overshadow”
- 100% God and 100% man – at the same time
- Without the virgin birth, Jesus couldn’t be the Messiah
- “Hand maid” – The lowest form of female servant
- Mary was ready with her “YES”

- “Come see a man”
- “Open your eyes and look at the fields”
