The Church in Antioch in Syria

- Scattered by persecution
- Shared the gospel only to Jews
- Some Believers went to Antioch and spoke to the Greeks
- A great number of people believed!
- News reached Jerusalem...sent Barnabas to Antioch
- Barnabas encouraged them to remain true to the Lord
- Barnabas went to Tarsus to get Paul...brought him to Antioch
- Paul and Barnabas taught the church for 1 year
- The disciples were called Christians first at Antioch

The church sent Paul and Barnabas on their first missionary journey

Acts 14:26

Paul and Barnabas returned to Antioch – where Paul wrote Galatians
