#### **Exodus 19:16-19 (NKJV)**

- <sup>16</sup> Then it came to pass on the third day, in the morning, that there were thunderings and lightnings, and a thick cloud on the mountain; and the sound of the trumpet was very loud, so that all the people who *were* in the camp trembled.
- <sup>17</sup> And Moses brought the people out of the camp to meet with God, and they stood at the foot of the mountain.
- <sup>18</sup> Now Mount Sinai *was* completely in smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire. Its smoke ascended like the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mountain quaked greatly.
- <sup>19</sup> And when the blast of the trumpet sounded long and became louder and louder, Moses spoke, and God answered him by voice.

#### **Exodus 24:3-8 (NKJV)**

- <sup>3</sup> So Moses came and told the people all the words of the LORD and all the judgments. And all the people answered with one voice and said, "All the words which the LORD has said we will do."
- <sup>4</sup> And Moses wrote all the words of the LORD. And he rose early in the morning, and built an altar at the foot of the mountain, and twelve pillars according to the twelve tribes of Israel.
- <sup>5</sup> Then he sent young men of the children of Israel, who offered burnt offerings and sacrificed peace offerings of oxen to the LORD.
- <sup>6</sup> And Moses took half the blood and put *it* in basins, and half the blood he sprinkled on the altar.
- <sup>7</sup> Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read in the hearing of the people. And they said, "All that the LORD has said we will do, and be obedient."
- <sup>8</sup> And Moses took the blood, sprinkled *it* on the people, and said, "This is the blood of the covenant which the LORD has made with you according to all these words."

#### Matthew 22:36-40 (NKJV)

- <sup>36</sup> "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?"
- <sup>37</sup> Jesus said to him, "'You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.'
- <sup>38</sup> This is *the* first and great commandment.
- <sup>39</sup> And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'
- <sup>40</sup> On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets."

<sup>21</sup> For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

#### 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NKJV)

<sup>17</sup> Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

#### **Exodus 20:1-21 (NKJV)**

- <sup>1</sup> And God spoke all these words, saying:
- <sup>2</sup> "I *am* the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

- <sup>3</sup> You shall have no other gods before Me.
- <sup>4</sup> "You shall not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness *of anything* that *is* in heaven above, or that *is* in the earth beneath, or that *is* in the water under the earth;
- <sup>5</sup> you shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, the LORD your God, *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth *generations* of those who hate Me,
- <sup>6</sup> but showing mercy to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.
- <sup>7</sup> "You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold *him* guiltless who takes His name in vain.
- <sup>8</sup> "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.
- <sup>9</sup> Six days you shall labor and do all your work,
- <sup>10</sup> but the seventh day *is* the Sabbath of the LORD your God. *In it* you shall do no work: you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger who *is* within your gates.
- <sup>11</sup> For *in* six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that *is* in them, and rested the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it.
- <sup>12</sup> "Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the LORD your God is giving you.
- 13 "You shall not murder.
- 14 "You shall not commit adultery.
- 15 "You shall not steal.
- <sup>16</sup> "You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- <sup>17</sup> "You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, nor his male servant, nor his female servant, nor his ox, nor his donkey, nor anything that *is* your neighbor's."

#### Galatians 4:1-7 (NKJV)

- <sup>1</sup> Now I say *that* the heir, as long as he is a child, does not differ at all from a slave, though he is master of all,
- <sup>2</sup> but is under guardians and stewards until the time appointed by the father.

- <sup>3</sup> Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under the elements of the world.
- <sup>4</sup> But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law,
- <sup>5</sup> to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.
- <sup>6</sup> And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!"
- <sup>7</sup> Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

# 1 John 1:7-9 (NKJV)

- <sup>7</sup> But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.
- <sup>8</sup> If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- <sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
